- ❖ Understands right, wrong, fair, and unfair.
- ❖ Can recognize simple words and may even be reading.
- ❖ Can name four or five colors.
- ❖ Has a vocabulary of six to eight words sentences.
- ❖ Can tell a simple story.
- ❖ Understands games have rules.
- ❖ Can skip, walk on tiptoes, and jump forward.
- ❖ Throws a ball overhand.
- ❖ Can cut with scissors and use glue.
- ❖ Can dress and undress without supervision.

Parenting Tips

- ❖ Listen to and show respect for your child.
- ❖ Continue reading to your child or read together.
- ❖ Color, paint, do crafts, and play board games with your child.
- ❖ Enhance your child's experience with trips to parks, libraries, zoos, and other points of interest.
- ❖ Begin age-appropriate chores, such as sorting laundry, setting the table, and cleaning the bedroom.
- ❖ Always show affection.
- ❖ Build self-esteem by allowing your child to solve problems.
- ❖ Encourage your child while working on a task.
